Current situation Basic law

- The regulation 223/2009 of the EP and of the Council on European statistics defines the basic principles.
- Access to confidential data for scientific purposes is enabled under the following conditions:
 - Only indirect identification possible
 - For statistical analyses for scientific purposes
 - Approval of NSIs required

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Implementing law

The (implementing) Commission Regulation 831/2002 describes the rules and conditions of access

- Mainly European Universities and Research bodies
- Access covered by contracts
- NSI should provide their consent for each research project
- Two modes of access are enabled
 - Delivered access of anonymised microdata to research institutions
 - Access in Eurostat safe centre in Luxembourg to non protected data

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Current situation NSIs collect data according to harmonized definitions/methodologies - NSIs transmit files to Eurostat for the sake of production of EU statistics - in some domains (mainly household statistics) microdata are transmitted - Methods for anonymisation are agreed with 27 MS - Files are prepared by Eurostat Eurostat handles research requests and releases data according to appropriate procedures eurostat What is available, what is delivered? ■ In 2011 - 12 surveys covered in the Regulation 831 but only 6 currently available: ECHP, LFS, CIS, AES, SILC, SES - Delivery of micro data : more then 200 contracts - Access in Eurostat safe center : 5 per year eurostat 🗀 Principles of the new draft Regulation ■ Users: recognized research entities ■ Purpose: statistical analysis for scientific purposes indicated in the research proposal ■ Datasets available: scientific use files (delivered access) - secure use files (access in secure environment) Access provided by Eurostat or another accredited entity: access facility Approval of access by MSs ■ Transparency and efficiency eurostat 🖸

Recognition of research entity Application form, confidentiality undertaking and terms of use to be signed by the head of research entity	
Assessment by Eurostat Publication of the name of research entity on Eurostat website	-
Research proposal Application form and confidentiality declaration to be signed by researchers having access to confidential data
